What Are Protestant Prayer Beads?

Protestant prayer beads are a simple tool to help guide prayer.

They consist of 33 or 34 beads arranged in a pattern that creates a gentle rhythm for prayer.

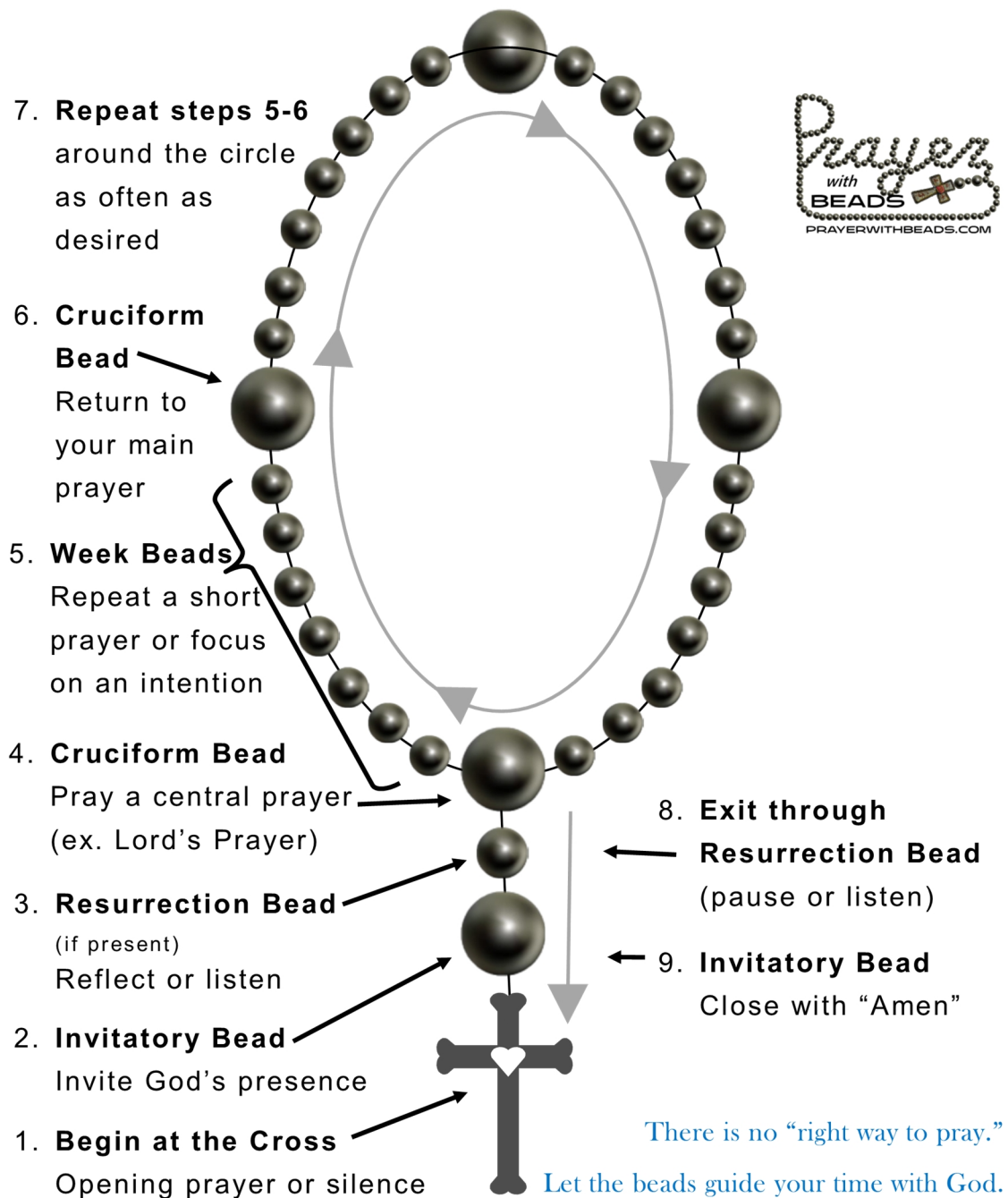
Unlike some traditions, there are no required prayers. You are free to pray in a way that is meaningful to you.

How to Pray with Protestant Prayer Beads

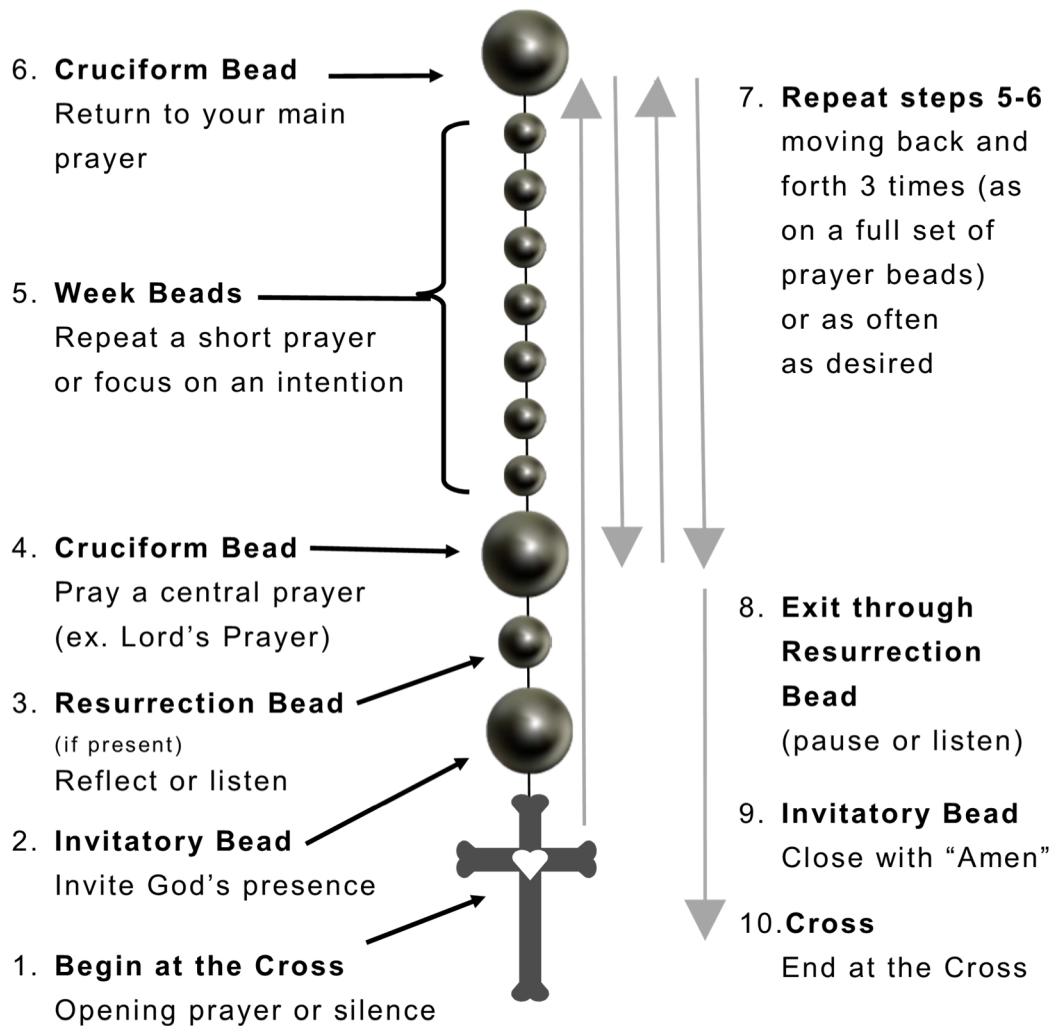
A simple step-by-step guide
